


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2022-2023 Course Syllabus

This is an accelerated course in Algebra which rigorously delves into abstract algebraic theories and applications. This course is designed for the student who has been extremely successful in mathematics and is highly motivated to learn. In addition to the material listed above, Algebra 2 Honors includes greater emphasis on complex numbers, logarithms and exponents.



50% Tests 2 or 3 per quarter

GRADING POLICY

TESTS (50%) — QUIZZES (35%)

Tests and quizzes are formal assessments that will be graded for accuracy. All assessments will be pre-scheduled and will be administered during class time. No retakes.

HOMEWORK / CLASSWORK (15%)

Homework and classwork checks are assigned daily and are designed to give extra practice on concepts covered during lessons. These assignments are to used to confirm that you are staying up-to-date with the class content. Each assignment will be checked based on both accuracy and effort, see attached rubric.
